RAISING ASPIRATIONS & REACHING FULL POTENTIAL

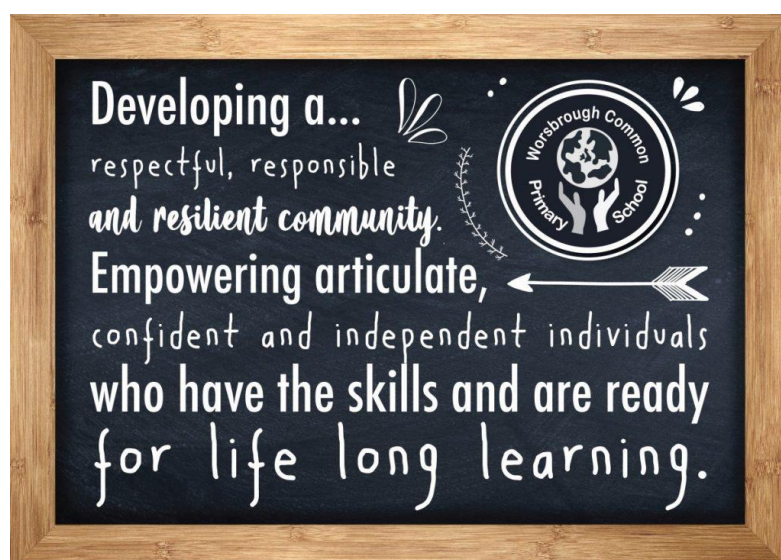

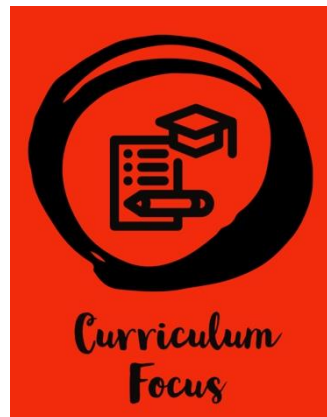




Worsbrough Common Primary School
