Y5 Vikings

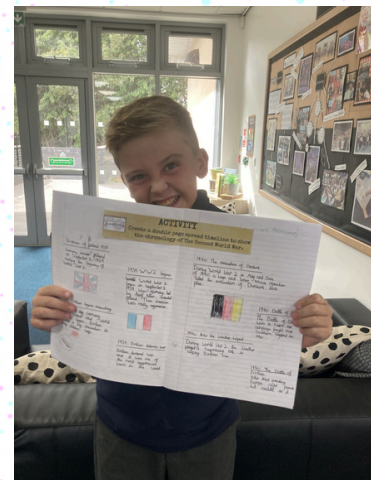
Y4 Victorians
