




Welcome back to school!

House Points

In Assembly today we have re-launched our House point system. At WCPS we have a real focus on positive behaviours and rewarding children with house points is part of this. Please take the time to encourage children to gain house points and talk to them about this.



House points are awarded to children for demonstrating our school values, including respect, resilience, responsibility, kindness, effort, and excellent work. Each classroom will have a visual display, such as a tally chart or counter jar, so pupils can clearly see their individual totals each week. Year 6 pupils have the opportunity to be House Captains. The overall totals for each house are shared weekly on the school website and are displayed in the school hall, so that children can see how their efforts contribute to their house. Parents and carers can also log in to Arbor to view their child's house points. A variety of rewards will be given to children and houses to celebrate their achievements and recognise the house points they have earned.
