teamwork!

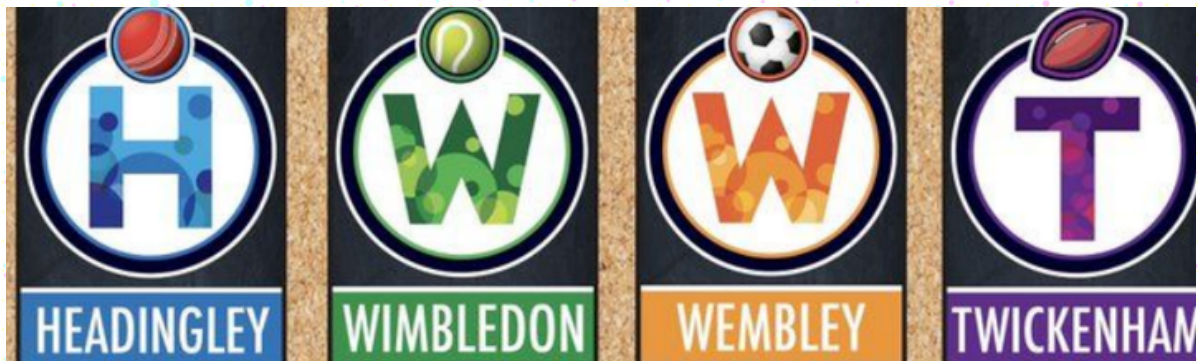
