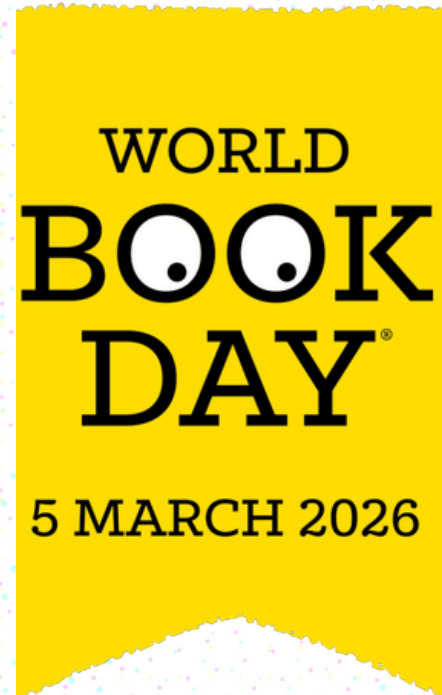
WORSBROUGH WEEKLY

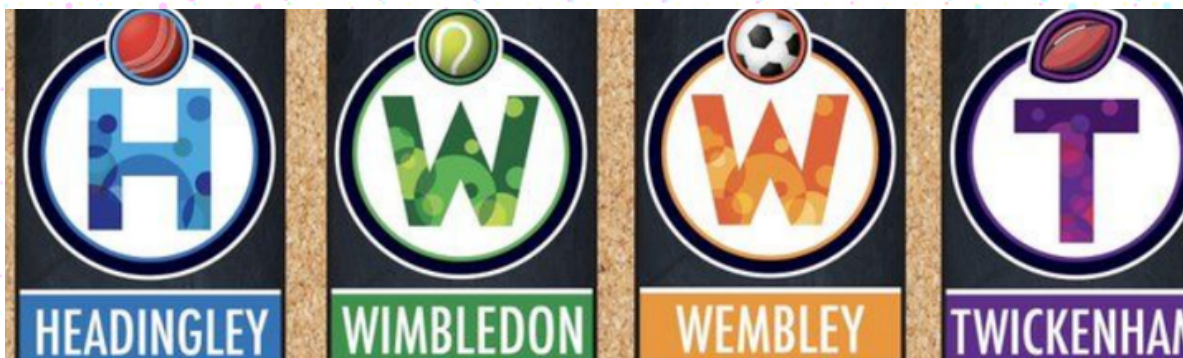
