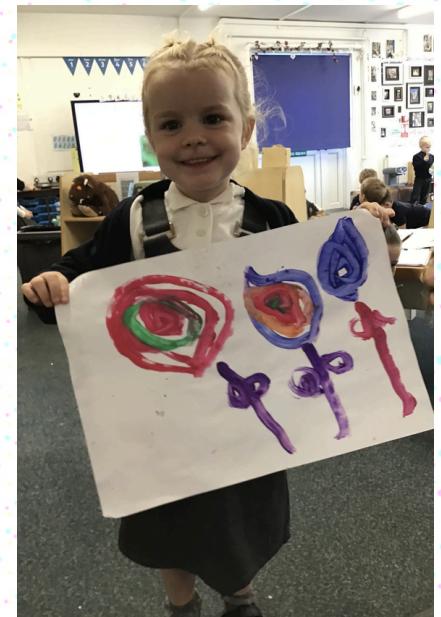

Vincent van Gogh's struggles

Famously, van Gogh cut a part of his ear off when he was in an argument with another artist. Vincent van Gogh struggled to get a job because he kept on getting fired because he kept on shouting at customers. He tried to become a teacher, a preacher, and tried to help in a art shop. He didn't have any money to buy supplies. He also had mental health issues which explains most of his life struggles but he carried on to paint.

Early life

He was born in 1853 in the Netherlands. The incredible artist got sent to boarding school when he was 11. While he was at boarding school, he missed walking on the slow, rickety carts in his home town.
