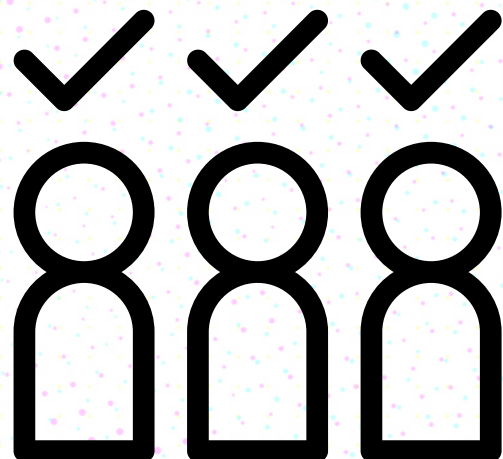
Attendance Matters!

If you are struggling with the morning routine or are worried about your child's attendance please speak to us. We are here to help.



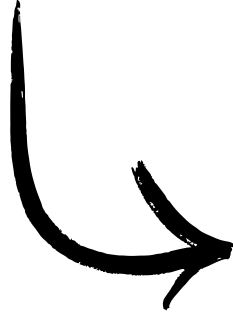


SCHOOL LIBRARY
